

## Literacy

The children will be focusing on working independently – thinking of their own ideas to write and using their phonic strategies to read and write fluently. We will be asking the children to re-read their work back once they have finished writing.

We will be concentrating on correct letter formation and neat handwriting.

## Mathematics

We will be consolidating our addition and subtraction skills. We will introduce doubling and halving. We will be encouraging the children to independently record their number sentences and looking at measuring height, weight, length and capacity.

In R.E. this term we will be looking at the Christian story of Creation and asking “Why is the word God so important to Christians?”

In Music this term, we will be learning a range of Nursery Rhymes and performing them with instruments. Our PSHCE will focus on relationships.

## Traditional Tales & Activities for this term:

Snow White- Mirror, Mirror on the wall self portraits.

Jack and the Beanstalk- Measuring, planting beans and writing instructions for planting beans.

Little Red Riding Hood- character descriptions and wanted posters.

Goldilocks and the 3 Bears- size comparison, writing letters.

Robin Hood- Learning and performing a poem.
