COVID-19

If you need to report a COVID-19 case or someone with symptoms out of normal school hours then please email slt@stpandstp.org.uk so that we can inform contacts to self-isolate and follow the government and public health procedures. We continue to follow the government guidance in school to keep everyone safe in their Pods and reduce contacts in school. Please remember to follow the guidance as parents and carers (wearing masks on school grounds, only 1 adult coming on site, dropping children off and then leaving swiftly) so that we can help keep the transmission of the virus down.

We will be continuing with all COVID-19 arrangements until the end of term – Thursday 22nd July. School arrangements for September will be sent out next week in line with the government guidance for Step 4 of the roadmap, however these are subject to change of the summer holidays, so please keep an eye on your emails towards the end of the holidays.

INCREASE IN PRICES

We have been advised by North Lincolnshire Council Catering that the costs of school lunches will increase to £2.40 from September, this will be updated on ParentPay from September.

The cost of breakfast club will also increase to £1.50 to cover the costs of staffing and providing a healthy breakfast, this is still a very reasonable price for childcare for the hour before school.

ATTENDANCE

We are committed to providing high quality education for all our children. In order for a child to reach their full potential, we expect a high level of school attendance. Holidays in term time are unauthorised, unless in exceptional circumstances and referred to the Education Inclusion Service, who may issue a Penalty Notice.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following: Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, The guarantee element of Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit), Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
