We will still collect donations for the Scunthorpe Food Bank to support families in our local community at time when many people are struggling financially. Please send donations into school from Friday 16th – Tuesday 20th October and then we will leave the donations for 72 hours before being collected by the foodbank. Please only send in non-perishable goods eg tins, packets etc. The children in each class will be taking part in a Harvest Worship, which will then be edited together on a video to share with parents.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Breakfast club is open for those parents who need to use it from 7.50am until the start of the school day. Children can arrive at any time between 7.50am and 8.30am when the gates are locked. Parents should have booked a place using the Google Form at the start of the school year or by contacting the school office to let us know your needs. This is so that we know the number of children needing a place each day, to ensure we have enough space to maintain separate bubbles across the school in line with the government COVID guidance on the safe re-opening of schools.

BIG TALK

We always use Big Talk Education to cover the statutory content for Relationships and Sex Education in the Autumn term. Big talk will be in school all day on Thursday 15th October delivering sessions to the children.



GOOGLE CLASSROOMS

In the next few days all Y1 – Y6 children will have logged into Google Classroom. Their login details will be sent home shortly. From next week we will be setting weekly home learning via Google Classroom. All children will have had several opportunities to use it in school before then, so they know how to use it. If a Pod is to close or a local lockdown is put in place, we will use Google Classroom to set daily lessons/work. You can login via the school website and Mrs Winfield will send all parents a step by step guide via parent pay next week.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following: Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, The guarantee element of Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit), Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
