WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL

It has been great to see all the children, parents and staff back at school over the last week and a pleasure to see how all the children have settled happily back into school and are engaged in their learning in classes.

Can I please ask that only one adult comes to the school gates for picking up and dropping off, to keep numbers as low as possible on site and on Redshank Drive and maintain social distancing.

The children are all coming in really independently in a morning and new Reception children are also starting to leave their parents at the gate, can we encourage all children to do this please.

If you wish to send your child into school with their own hand sanitiser you can do so, there are ones which clip to your clothes or they can have a named bottle on their desk.

PARENT TEACHER MEETINGS

We will be holding Parent Teacher meetings via phone call towards the end of September so that all class teachers can talk with parents about how their child has settled back into school. We usually update our data collection forms at face to face meetings in the autumn term, but cannot do that this year.
