COVID-19

If you need to report a COVID-19 case or someone with symptoms out of normal school hours then please email slt@stpandstp.org.uk so that we can inform contacts to self-isolate and follow the government and public health procedures. We continue to follow the government guidance in school to keep everyone safe in their Pods and reduce contacts in school. Please remember to follow the guidance as parents and carers (wearing masks on school grounds, only 1 adult coming on site, dropping children off and then leaving swiftly) so that we can help keep the transmission of the virus down.

PARENTPAY

We use ParentPay to communicate to parents via email and text as well as for collecting dinner money, breakfast club money and trip monies. Can I ask that you check your email and mobile phone numbers are up to date for your accounts, so that you do not miss any important communication. As we move through the summer term and restrictions ease we are hoping that we will be able to start organising some trips for the children and the details of these will be on ParentPay.

ATTENDANCE

We are committed to providing high quality education for all our children. In order for a child to reach their full potential, we expect a high level of school attendance. Holidays in term time are unauthorised, unless in exceptional circumstances and referred to the Education Inclusion Service, who may issue a Penalty Notice.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following: Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, The guarantee element of Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit), Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
