PE UNIFORM

Can I remind you again of the PE uniform and expectations that **ALL** children should adhere to. **PE Kit:** Non logo / branded plain white t-shirt, dark plain jogging bottoms, leggings (NOT SKINS) or shorts, plimsolls for PE in the hall, trainers for PE outside (these should be sporting, running shoes – not 'fashion' wear eg Converse or VANS). School jumpers may be worn if the weather requires an extra layer.

Jewellery in school: In the interests of health and safety only watches and small stud earrings may be worn and they **MUST** be removed by the child for PE. Children will be asked to remove any other items of jewellery. Please avoid new ear piercing during school terms and only **one lobe** piercing is allowed.

ATTENDANCE

We are committed to providing high quality education for all our children. In order for a child to reach their full potential, we expect a high level of school attendance. Holidays in term time are unauthorised, unless in exceptional circumstances and referred to the Education Inclusion Service, who may issue a Penalty Notice or prosecution.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following: Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, The guarantee element of Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit), Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
