BREAKFAST CLUB SEPTEMBER

Due to rising costs of employment and food supplies we have made the difficult decision to increase our Breakfast Club pricing from the current £1.50 to £2 with effect from September. Having done research in the local area this still leaves us as the cheapest provider - other schools are charging between £2.50 and £5.50 with some not even providing fresh food as an option. Can we please also ask that you pay for breakfast club places in advance to prevent our admin staff having to chase for payment and to potentially avoid your child not being allocated a place.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are all entitled to a free school meal as part of the governments universal infant free school meal programme. Children in Year 3 – 6 have to apply for free school meals. All parents/carers can apply for free school meals in any year group as there are other benefits other than the free school meal. The school receives extra money into the school budget and the eligible families currently receive vouchers for food through the holiday periods. Please check, via the link below, to see if you are eligible, which ever year group your child is in, and especially if your child is moving from Year 2 into Year 3 in September.

ATTENDANCE

We are committed to providing high quality education for all our children. In order for a child to reach their full potential, we expect a high level of school attendance. Holidays in term time are unauthorised, unless in exceptional circumstances and referred to the Education Inclusion Service, who may issue a Penalty Notice or prosecution.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following: Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance,

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, The guarantee element of Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit), Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
