Uniform

Please remember our school uniform policy. Only watches (no smart watches) and **small square/circular stud earrings** may be worn and they must be removed for PE. Children will be asked to remove any other items of jewellery. Please no new ear piercing during school terms. Children should not have painted or false nails in school. On non PE days normal school uniform should be worn which is Trousers, shorts, pinafores, skirts these can be navy, grey or black. Blouses, shirts or polo tops and these should be white. **Sports trainers** to be worn only on PE days with black shoes/trainers for the rest of the time. **Winter coats** are also needed every day please.

We encourage all children to come to school with a suitably sized water bottle and thank you for supporting this at home by filling them with water. Please could we ask that the children do not bring them to school inside their book bags as we have had a number of reading books ruined through water leaking from the bottles as the children carry them in.

ATTENDANCE

We are committed to providing high quality education for all our children. In order for a child to reach their full potential, we expect a high level of school attendance. Holidays in term time are unauthorised, unless in exceptional circumstances and referred to the Education Inclusion Service, who may issue a Penalty Notice.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following: Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, The guarantee element of Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit), Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
