Mobile Phone Agreement

You may be aware from the press that last week Bridget Phillipson (Secretary of State for Education) sent all schools an email 'Strengthened guidance on mobile phones in schools', that schools should be a phone-free environment for the entire school day. This is our policy already, so nothing has changed for us. Children who bring their phones to school should continue to hand them in to their teacher at the start of the day and collect them at the end of the school day, we will keep them secure. In the light of this guidance, we have put together a mobile phone agreement for parents to sign. You will be contacted by school with this agreement via Arbor if your child brings a phone into school – please sign this by February 13th. From now on, before your child brings a device to school, the agreement will need to be signed first so please contact the school office before sending it in to school. We are also following this up with a tightened policy on the use of mobile phones in school to fully reflect the latest DFE guidance.

ATTENDANCE

We are committed to providing high quality education for all our children. In order for a child to reach their full potential, we expect a high level of school attendance. Holidays in term time are unauthorised, unless in exceptional circumstances and referred to the Education Inclusion Service, who may issue a Penalty Notice.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following: Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, Income Support, Income-based Job Seekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, The guarantee element of Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit), Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
